# WHAT DO OUR PARENTS SAY?

# WHAT DO OUR CHILDREN SAY...?

(YEAR 7 SURVEY MAY 2016)

100% of children feel safe at school

99% of children feel that any incidents of bullying are dealt with quickly and effectively

99% of children say that pupils are kind and helpful at Scissett Middle School

100% of children know how to stay safe on line and what to do if they have a problem on line

99% of children say they know how to get help if they have a problem

100% of pupils say that their teachers help them to improve and 99% believe that teachers expect them to work hard.
